Welcome to Nature Camps at Steele

Creek Park; is your child ready for a nature filled week full of hiking, plants, animals, and excitement?



We hope you are all ready for this exhilarating week full of learning! Here, we hope to let you know what to expect, and what we expect of you and your camper(s), so that all who attend Nature Camps at Steele Creek Park have a fun and enriching experience.

Purpose: Summer Nature Camps at the Park have been ongoing now for more than 15 years. For each camp, we strive to provide a valuable outdoor learning experience for elementary – middle school age children. Each camp focuses on a different aspect of the Park's natural resources and heritage, and programming ranges from hikes and games, to indoor crafts and programs.

The Camp Experience: Each camp operates for 5 days (Monday - Friday) from 8:30 am – 12:00 pm. Early arrival and later pick-ups are not available. We give the children several breaks throughout the morning and invite parents to send snacks with their children (and we recommend that you send water with your children!). While we prefer to spend most of each camp day outside exposing the campers to *real* nature, we do have indoor activities during inclement weather, and also spend a significant amount of time introducing them to tools of the trade for nature observation and study.

Cost: While nearly all of the Nature Center's educational programming is performed as a free service to the public, in order to provide materials and staffing for these learning-intensive camps, a fee of \$55.00 (\$50.00 if paid before May 31st) is required of each participant per camp. Payment is due within 2 weeks of registration or 2 weeks prior to the first day of camp (whichever is earlier).

If payment is a problem, however, the Friends of Steele Creek Nature Center and Park have several camp scholarships each year for parents in need of assistance. More information is available on their website,

Rules and Expectations:

Your child's safety is essential to us! Our camp leaders strive to keep the experience safe and enjoyable for all campers, but this responsibility <u>must</u> be a shared one!

Some accidents cannot be avoided, but to minimize the risk to your child or someone else's, these rules must be followed by <u>all</u> campers at <u>all</u> times:

- Campers are to stay as a group and with group leaders at ALL times.
- When a leader is speaking, campers are listening.
- Campers are not to touch any living thing unless a leader says that it is safe.
- Campers are to keep their hands to themselves.
- Running and horseplay are not permitted.

These rules will travel with us throughout each week, and other rules will be necessary during specific events and activities. For the safety of everyone, if your child cannot adhere to these or other requirements, we will not allow the child back to camp and no refund will be given.

Remember, this is real exposure to a wilderness park! If you have any doubts about your child's enjoyment or wellbeing, discuss this with us before signing him or her up for camp!
