
Summer Nature Camps 2015

Botany Camp – Wildflowers, trees, shrubs, mosses and ferns (and much more!) will be the focus of this camp! Campers will hike to remote areas of the park studying plants and the habitats they are a part of. Kids will also learn botanical methods and assist with our park's herbarium! Ages 10-13, June 22nd - 26th

Animal Tracking & Orienteering Camp - Map and compass, shelter building and survival skills, identifying animal tracks and droppings, this camp is all about staying safe and having fun in the great outdoors. Ages 10-13, July 6th - 10th EXTRA WEEK for Ages 7-9, July 20th - 24th



Insects and Creepy Crawlies Camp –

From the beautiful, to the weird, to just plain gross, this camp will explore the invertebrate world in Steele Creek Park! Stream sampling, butterfly watching, forest walks, and log rolling are just a few of the activities campers will participate in. Ages 7-9. July $13^{th} - 17^{th}$
