FRIENDS OF STEELE CREEK NATURE CENTER AND PARK 2016 AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST RULES

- To be eligible, an entrant may not derive more than 10% of their income from work as a photographer and may not regularly compete in and/or have photographs accepted for exhibition in other regional (i.e. <u>beyond the Tri Cities region</u>), national, or international competitions. The following individuals may submit entries, but are ineligible for prizes: Friends Board members and their immediate family members, and jurors and their immediate family members.
- 2. Photographs must have been taken within the boundaries of Steele Creek Park, and should focus on the natural aspects of the park. Photographs will be judged on general interest, creativity, and technical quality. Jurors will be professional or experienced amateur photographers from the local community. All decisions made by the jurors will be final.
- 3. Entrants must have full rights to any photographs submitted. Photographs may not have been previously published and may not have won any previous contest.
- 4. Friends of Steele Creek Nature Center and Park ("Friends") will retain non-exclusive rights to use the images for educational, promotional or fundraising purposes without obtaining further permission and/or providing compensation to the photographers. Credit will be given to the photographer whenever an image is used.
- 5. There will be two divisions for submissions: Adult and Youth. Youth must be *younger than* 16 as of October 1, 2016 (i.e. birth date after October 1, 2000).
- 6. An individual may submit up to four photographs for a single entry fee of \$5.00. Additional photographs may be submitted by the same individual for additional entry fees of \$5.00 per four entries. Each photograph must be accompanied by a separate, completed application form.
- 7. Submitted photographs must be *prints*, *at least* 5"x7", and must be *mounted on firm backing* no larger than 16"x20". They do not need to be matted, and *may not be framed or covered with glass*. Color and black and white prints are acceptable. *To be eligible for prizes, digital files of the images must be submitted in addition to the prints*.
- 8. Prizes will be awarded for one or more photographs in each division for which there are sufficient submissions (i.e. a total of at least 10 photographs submitted by at least 3 photographers in the division). The value of the award(s) will be determined prior to the judging, based in part on the number of entries in each division. In any event, the minimum prize amounts for first place will be \$50 for the adult division and \$25 for the youth division. Additional prizes, ribbons and certificates may also be awarded.
- 9. Entries may be submitted, beginning August 8th, 2016, by mail to Friends of Steele Creek Nature Center and Park, P.O. Box 1763, Bristol, TN 37620, or in person at the Bristol Tennessee Department of Parks and Recreation office, 325 McDowell Street, Bristol, TN, weekdays between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm. Entry fees must accompany all mailed photographs as well as those dropped off at the Parks and Recreation office. Deadline for receipt of entries and entry fees is 4:00 pm, Friday, September 23rd, 2016.
- 10. Electronic copies of the entries may be submitted with the prints as above, or may be e-mailed to mail@friendsofsteelecreek.org.
- 11. All submissions will be displayed at Wildlife Weekend at Steele Creek Park (October 7th & 8th, 2016). Winners will be announced at Wildlife Weekend on Friday evening, October 7th. Winners do not need to be present to receive awards.
- 12. Photos will be returned to all photographers who request them. However, entrants are encouraged to donate their print submissions to "Friends". Many entries from previous years are now on permanent display in various venues around the city of Bristol, TN.
- 13. Photographers wishing to have their prints returned may:
 - a. pick them up at Wildlife Weekend (at the Steele Creek Lodge) on October 8th between 3:00 pm and 4:00 pm; or
 - b. pick them up at the Bristol Tennessee Department of Parks and Recreation office (325 McDowell Street) during office hours (10:00 am to 4:00 pm) between October 10th and November 11th; or
 - c. have them returned by mail if a pre-addressed, postage-paid envelope of appropriate size is provided with the entry.

Prints not claimed by November 11th, 2016 will become the property of Friends of Steele Creek Nature Center and Park.
