

Summer Nature Camps 2024!

Geology Rocks Camp - The connection between Earth and space will be the focus of this camp. Rocks, minerals, fossils, biology, physics, and weather will all be explored. Ages 13-15 June $3^{rd} - 7^{th}$

Herpetology Camp - In this camp, kids will be introduced to the exciting world of Herpetology (the study of amphibians & reptiles). Frogs, toads, snakes, salamanders, turtles, and lizards will be searched for throughout Steele Creek Park.

Ages 10–12 June $10^{th} - 14^{th}$

Nature Discovery Camp - Does moss *really* only grow on the north side of the tree? How can you tell a venomous from a nonvenomous snake? We'll be learning the basics of the woods and creeks while we explore the unique habitats in the Southern Appalachians.

Ages 7–9 June $17^{th} - 21^{st}$

Conservation Camp – "Reduce, reuse, recycle" are just the beginning of this camp! Participants will learn about ecology, composting, sustainability, and much more.

Ages 10–12 June 24th – 28th

Art in Nature Camp - Nature campers explore their creative sides in this brand new camp! Mixed media, journaling, basic meditation techniques, and more will coalesce to create naturally-inspired works of art! Ages 7–9 July 8th – 12th

Trailblazer Camp - Trailblazers will do just that: hike many miles of Steele Creek Park's interior while learning trail basics, orienteering, wildlife (and more!) along the way. Ages 13–15 July 15th – 19th

All camps operate from 8:30 am until noon Monday – Friday and space is limited. The registration fee is \$50.00, which includes a t-shirt, all materials needed for camp, and two complimentary entries into the 2024 Wildlife Weekend Photography Contest.
